EXAMPLE :

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Sri Arumugam Teacher Training College, Rajanagar, Valthiyanathapuram, Tholudur - 606 303, Tholudore District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Secondary (B.Ed) course.

SRC-NCTE caused inspection of the institution on 23.05.2005. Upon consideration of sitting team report and other documents furnished by the institution, the SRC in its 97th meeting held on 27th July, 2005 decided to accord recognition for B.Ed programme with an intake of 100 from the session 2006-07 as the documents submitted by the institution were belated for being considered for the current academic year 2005-2006 in view of Appendix I-B of NCTE regulations, 2002. Accordingly a recognition order was issued to the institution vide TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/3300 dated 03.10.2005.

However, in the meanwhile some institutions who have been granted recognition for the subsequent year based on belated endorsements preferred an appeal to NCTE Hqrs. and contended that a few institutions which have submitted belated endorsements were granted recognition for the current academic year. SRC, in its comments to the NCTE Hqrs. explained that this has occurred due to oversight and would modify such orders which have been wrongly issued. Pursuant to this, the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi, No.F.No.89-156/2005-Appeal dated 28th September, 2005 remanded back the cases to the SRC, Bangalore with a direction to reconsider the cases immediately for granting recognition from 2005-2006 on par with other similar cases who have been granted recognition for 2005-2006.

The same has been placed before SRC in its 103rd meeting held on 27th and 28th October, 2005 and SRC after obtaining a considered legal opinion in this regard, has taken a decision to review its recognition orders issued for the session 2006-07 and to grant recognition for the session 2005-06 to those institutions who have submitted belated NOCs/Endorsements as one time exception. Subsequently, SRC in its 104th meeting held on 9th November, 2005 decided to extend this relaxation to the institutions which have submitted other essential documents mentioned in Appendix 1B, belatedly.

Hence the modified order

Order

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Sree Arumugam Teacher Training College, Rajanagar, Valthyanathapuram, Tholudur - 606 303, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Secondary (B.Ed) Course of One year from the academic session 2005 - 06.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
- c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs.
- d. The institution has selected the Principal and Seven teachers for the said course.

3. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Sree Arumugam Teacher Training College, Rajanagar, Valthyanathapuram, Tholudur - 606 303, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu to offer Secondary (B.Ed) course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 100 students, subject to fulfillment of the following.

- a) The institution will ensure that Eight exclusive faculty members (Principal and Seven teachers) duly approved by the affiliating university are in position for an intake of 100 students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course.
- b) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
- c) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993

The earlier Recognition Order issued to the institution vide F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/3300 dated 03.10.2005 stands withdrawn.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution **Sri Armugam Teacher Training College, Rajanagar, Vaithyanathapuram, Tholudur – 606303, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in **B.Ed** which require additional facilities.

3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not maintained/revalidated the Fixed Deposited Receipts towards Endowment and Reserve Funds.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall submit revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition will be withdrawn.
- II. The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- III. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- IV. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Sri Armugam Teacher Training College, Rajanagar, Vaithyanathapuram, Tholudur – 606303, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-16 subject to submission of revalidated FDRs of the enhanced value in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 and fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at II & III herein before 31.10.2015.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a chartered Accountant.

8. The institutions shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made of issued there under , the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

CONTINUATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Sree Arumugam Teacher Training College, Rajanagar, vaithyanathapuram, Tholudar-606303, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/3300 dated 03.10.2005 for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2006-2007.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dated 20.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 30.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th – 15th September, 2020 has considered the matters and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT report not accompanied with the requisite documents. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 08.06.2021. The institution vide letter dated 01.07.2021 has submitted reply to the Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 400th meeting held on 13th – 14th July 2021 and the Committee decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

*The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Sri Arumugam Teacher Training College, Survey No. 66/5, Vaithiyathapuram Village, Rajanagar, Vaithyanathapuram, Tholudur, Cuddalore District-606303, Tamilnadu** for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each."*

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., **Sri Arumugam Teacher Training College, Survey No. 66/5, Vaithiyathapuram Village, Rajanagar, Vaithyanathapuram, Tholudur, Cuddalore District-606303, Tamilnadu** for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two year duration (2 basic units) of 50 students each subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

6. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme (s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

9. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.


10. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

11. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.
